### **Awarded by the Southgate Optimist Club**

The Southgate Optimist Club was formed in 1946 as a community organization with the goal supporting the youth of Southgate, KY. Since its inception the Southgate Optimist Club has provided many educational and recreational programs for the city's youth. Continuing an 18 year tradition, the Optimist Club will again award two \$500 high school scholarships this year. The award is paid out \$125 per year starting in the student's freshman year.

The scholarships will go to a graduating 8<sup>th</sup> grade student, one each from St Therese School and Southgate Independent Schools. It is in memory of Edward (Sunny) Schumann, father of Optimist member Edward Schumann Jr.

Eligible applicants must be a resident of the City of Southgate or be a family member of a member of the Southgate Optimist Club. Awarding of the scholarship will be based on academic achievements, extra-curricular activities and community involvement

The deadline for receiving applications is May 1, 2023. Completed application should be submitted the principal of the school for which student is attending.
